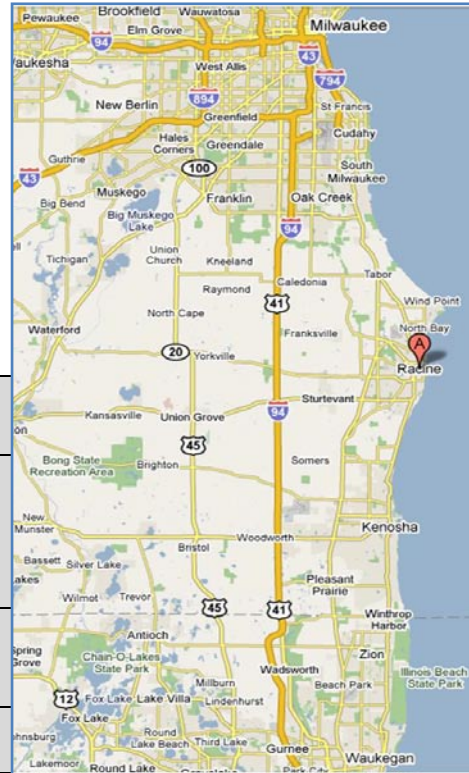


# A Profile of Racine County, Wisconsin
